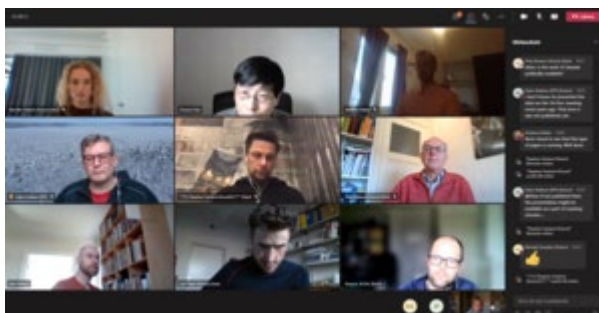

The competition was launched in August 2020 and received 118 entries from all over the world.

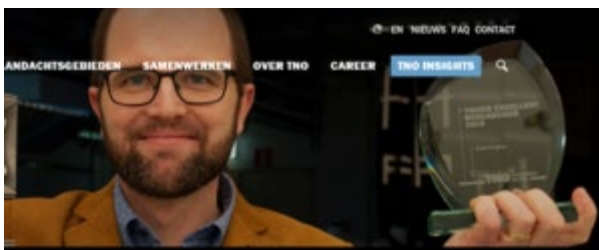

ClimApp meeting focusing on WP1 deliverables with a small group of partners while they were participating in PPTR conference in Croatia.

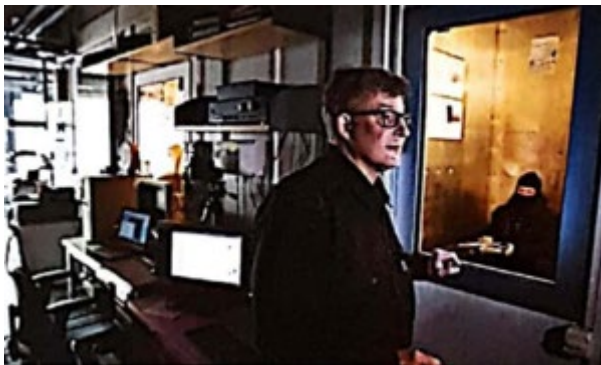

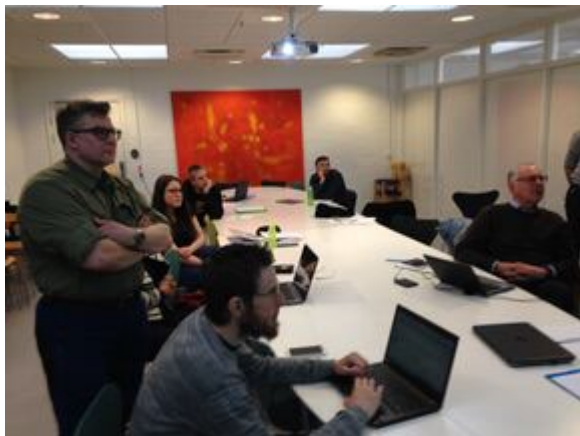
