ART PROBING AND EMERGING TECHNOLOGIES

I work as both an artist and a researcher, sometimes combining the activities. As an artist I create works that explore imaginaries, mediation and human experiences of emerging technologies. My art is positioned in the borderland to my work as an ethnologist, cultural analyst and a scholar of digital cultures. I use my research partly to spur artistic concepts, which means that my artworks have often emanated from research questions. This work can subsequently be used as something I call art probes. The probes have been developed for different clients, as commissioned work or to spark inspiration and material for my own research.
